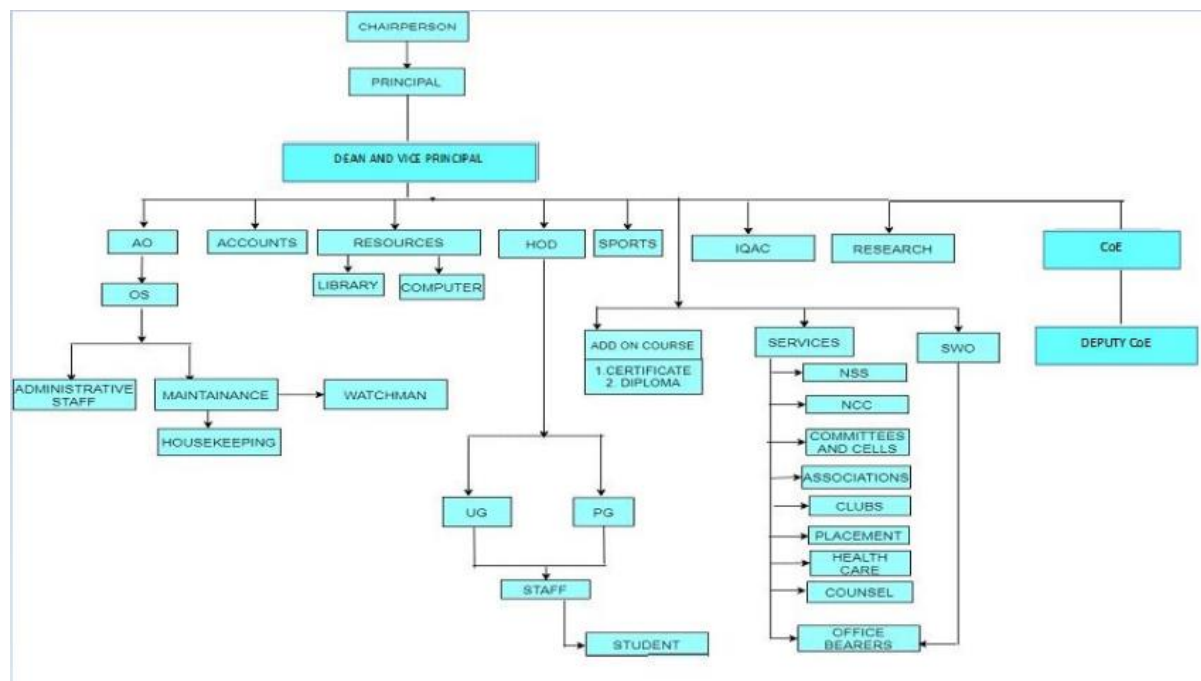

- **Barrier Free Built Environment for disabled and elderly persons**

The following Infrastructure and other support measures are provided to persons with physical disabilities:

1. Ramps/Rails, Lifts, Special Toilets, Parking Lots, Scribes and assisting devices like Wheelchairs, walking-aids, hearing aids etc
2. Wheelchair users can move without others help. Provision of Ramps with minimum width of 1.5 Meters along with handrails at entrances, exits and passages.
3. Adequate space (1.2 Meters) is provided for movement of wheelchair users to enter into classrooms, laboratories, toilets and other areas within the building.
4. Ramp slope is 1:12 for climbing by wheelchair users, even when they have a care giver, to push steep slopes can be painful.
5. Provision of lifts to Accommodate wheelchair users to move different floors.
6. Handrails for persons who use Crutches with anti-skid (non-slip) floors,
7. Accessible toilets with provision of handrails in urinals, wheelchair access to utilities like washbasin. Health facets, etc.
8. Reserved designated parking.

Special Provisions for persons with Disabilities in the examination:

1. The Management is extending the benefit of two merit scholarships of Rs.20,000/- per student every year for the differently abled students commencing from the year 2022-23.
2. Provision of scribes (as per the guidelines issued by the department of Empowerment of persons with disabilities, Government of India) for students who find difficulty in writing, visual impairments, etc during examinations both CIE and SEE.
3. Extension of time up to 20 minutes per hour given to the students who uses scribes and students find difficulty in writing examinations.

4. Permission to make adequate arrangements for use of computers for writing examinations by persons with print disabilities with provision of softcopy of question paper in accessible format.

- **Teaching Learning Process**

BMSCW faculty adopt numerous student centric methods for enhancing the learning experience of the students. The following approaches are designed to actively engage students, cater to their different learning styles, and help build deeper understanding of the subject matter.

Experiential Learning

- Field/Industrial visits – Industrial visits are undertaken which offer opportunities to connect academic theories to practical applications.
- Capstone Projects – Students showcase their cumulative learning experiences in the final year of study through capstone projects which requires critical thinking, decision making and team work resulting in community engagement or seeking solutions for societal issues.
- Mini-projects – During the second and third year of study, students execute mini-projects as part of the alternate assessment in few specific courses. Multi-disciplinary projects are encouraged across departments leading to more holistic and effective outcomes.
- Student Club activities – The numerous technical clubs of the institute provide an excellent platform for developing competencies of event planning, logistics, teamwork, entrepreneurial thinking, decision making, leadership, collaboration and adaptability.

Participative Learning

- Lectures and Lab sessions – group discussion, Think-pair-share, online polls, class quizzes, Q&A sessions, case studies, role play, simulations, virtual labs etc enhance student engagement in class and lab sessions.
- Guest lectures – Students are exposed to real-world expertise, networking opportunities and practical insights of a course through guest lectures delivered by subject matter experts and industry personnel.
- Skill Building Workshops & Value-added courses – Content beyond the syllabus is offered to foster better practical skills relevant to

respective engineering stream.

- Peer Learning – This collaborative learning has been effectively adopted to build a positive learning environment in classrooms.
- Student Seminars: The students regularly participate in seminars wherein papers are presented on technical topics to enrich their learning experience.

Problem solving Methodologies

- Tutorial Sessions – These sessions (at least one in every semester) are designed to help students develop problem-solving through practice and guided learning.
- Computational Thinking – Computational thinking is applicable to all engineering streams which helps students approach a problem in a systematic way, promoting effective decision making.
- Flipped Classroom – In this instructional strategy, classroom time is dedicated to problem solving exercises leading to effective collaboration among peers.
- Hackathon/Codethon Activities - The technical clubs organise many coding sessions and competitions to tackle real world problems within a limited timeframe. Hackathons are used as an assessment tool in courses since this skillset is highly valued in the professional world.
- Competitive Programming – Students are challenged to solve complex algorithmic and computational problems efficiently on competitive coding platforms, which helps them during the placements.
- Usage of Tools – Tools which span a range of domains, from software applications for simulation and analysis to physical tools for measurement and testing are used for engineering problem solving. Python libraries, Tableau, Power BI, Different IDE's (Eclipse, Microsoft Visual Studio, etc.), Oracle RDBMS, R Studio, Git are some of the tools which facilitate problem solving.

The institution has provided facilities that include Smart boards, LCD, Language Lab, seminar hall and auditorium, Video Conferencing and others.

Academic Calendar: The Dean (Academics) in consultation with the Principal and Vice-Principal (Academics) prepare the Academic Calendar of the institution. The draft calendar is presented in the College Council for approval. The approved calendar is circulated to the stakeholders and posted on the college website. The calendar of

events includes important academic activities to assist the students and the faculty. Calendar includes Course registration, Internal Tests, Quizzes, alternate assessments, course dropping or withdrawal deadlines and last working day of the semester.

Adherence to Academic calendar: Departmental Academic Planner and Calendar is prepared which is aligned with Institute's academic calendar. Adherence to the academic calendar is ensured through audits conducted at the department level and at the institute level by IQAC and Dean (Academics). Care is taken to schedule all the internal tests and semester end examinations as planned in the academic calendar. Thus an academic calendar provides a complete frame work for all the activities in an academic year.
